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



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

Salzburg, Austria

Looking for a European destination that blends fairy-tale architecture, mountain adventures, and family-friendly fun? **Salzburg** hits all the right notes. Famous as the birthplace of Mozart and the backdrop for *The Sound of Music*, this charming Austrian city is packed with kid-friendly attractions, walkable streets, and scenic views that delight both kids and adults.

Here's what to explore on your Salzburg family getaway:



Top Family-Friendly Highlights:

-  **Hohensalzburg Fortress** – Ride the funicular up to this hilltop castle for panoramic views, ancient walls to explore, and hands-

on exhibits that kids actually enjoy.

-  **Mozart's Birthplace & Residence** – For music lovers big and small, this interactive museum lets kids learn about Mozart's life and play with instruments.

 -  [Boutique Hotel Auersperg](#) near Mirabell Gardens. The hotel offers family suites and a garden in a very peaceful location.

Where to Eat with Kids:

-  **Augustiner Bräu Mülln** – A sprawling beer garden with a kid-friendly food options. Very relaxed vibe and even includes a small play set for the kids to stayed entertained!
-  **L'Osteria Salzburg** – Pizzas and pasta! Offers larger booths, and a bustling atmosphere—perfect for families and picky eaters.
-  **Icezeit Gelateria** – Artisan ice cream made with regional and sustainable ingredients. A sweet treat after sightseeing!


